Overall School Report:

- Chen dance for 3rd grade in conjunction with study of China
- Comfort Dog visit today, 1/16
- We had equity family meeting last week about engaging other cultural professional development. We do this every year. Our staff and family engage in dialogue about how best to involve our vast diverse families.
- We have collaboration with NYC kids with theatre trained kids with 1st grade classes and 2nd grade, using puppets and how to engage kids and their identity.
- We planned a Lion dance performance for lunar new years like all the other years.
- We're doing set work for physiotherapist Zoe biasing , talking about body positivity, this is part of wellness agenda
 - Peer meditation training which is a come back after covid
- We want families come during lunch with parents with professional and talents to teach kids during free time
- Device ban - it's the higher grade but we put them away , we are investing in yonder pouches to put the

Q : With the new Chancellor did you get to learn anything about the new rules ?

The kids who are struggling need more time more diff approach to help them. The idea is to become better small groups to work with teachers from different classrooms.

2 hrs of PD instructional planning. MTSS(multi-tiered system of support)

Treasurer's Report: Rachel

- We have raised \$174K with the goal to raise being \$195K
- Merch Sales is \$20K its 17% of the target. We now have new designs in the PS29 merch and will be out in Feb.
- We raised a lot during Eat, Pie, Shop this school year which was \$15K which is \$3K more than the Goal.
- Notable revenue in December:
 - +\$123K in donations incl. corporate matching
 - +\$12K from Eat Pie & Shop
 - +\$3.7K from Merch sales
- Notable expenses in December:
 - -\$12K for 4th Grade ballroom dancing
 - -\$2.1K for Library & Tech supplies
 - -\$1.5K for Staff holiday gifts

Fundraising Report:

- As per Dec we collected 174k or 89% We are doing better than thought
- This years goal is: \$195K
