



- Probes through the wall

Elevator

- Pour concrete for elevator
- Clear all the spaces adjacent to the elevator

Class Size Reduction

Applying to get to 100% Compliance

- Asking for an additional 6 funded teachers
 - Increase kindergarten section from five sections of 25 to six sections of 20
 - Increase 2nd grade by one section
 - Increase 3rd grade by one section, add ICT class
 - Increase 5th grade by one section

Challenges


Direct Appeal 2025-26

Budget Amendment

Requesting approval to allocate up to \$25,000 from PS29 PTA reserves

- Funds will be used to hire two school aides through the end of the school year
- Aides will assist with:
 - Lunch and recess supervision
 - General administrative tasks
- Aides are hired from vetted and senior PS29+ afterschool staff
